They give information to guests and rangers, free educational guided walks in the area, lessons and games for children.



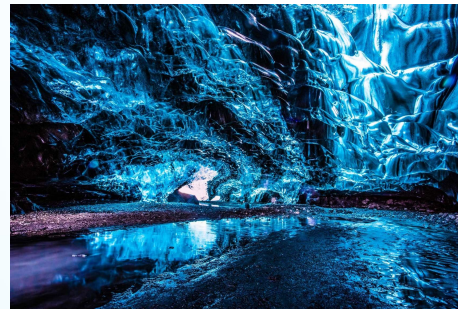
Ideology of the National Park
